



## Aletha Brown

November 12, 1923 - August 25, 2012

Aletha Brown, age 88, was a homemaker and started making a home for Doyl during WWII while he was stationed in Arkansas, Louisiana and Texas. After the War, they returned to Wynne and established a home on Hamilton Avenue, where they lived for almost 70 years and raised their three sons.

When Clyne entered school, Aletha became a room mother, substitute teacher, former PTA and Band Boosters President. She continued these activities until youngest son finished school 23 years later.

She was a member of the Hospital auxiliary, former president and managed the hospital gift shop for 25 years, which helped finance nursing education program and hospital improvements.

She was a volunteer for the Red Cross Blood Programs. She also volunteered as an ambassador for the Chamber of Commerce and visited new residents of Wynne.

She was very active in the Wynne Presbyterian Church, where she served as a Church School Teacher, committee member and in the Ladies Auxiliary.

Survivors are husband, Doyl Brown of the home; sons, Doyl Byron Brown and wife Betsy of Florida; Kevin Lyle Brown of Washington D. C.; daughter-in-law, Marice Brown Boardman of Tennessee; granddaughters, Megan Kelly and husband Brian of Oregon; Emily Brown of Florida; brother, Eldred Adams and wife Rosetta of Georgia.

She was preceded in death by her parents, Barney Adams and Annis Catterton Adams and her son, Reuel Clyne Brown.

Graveside services will be Tuesday, August 28, 2012 at 9 AM at Crosslawn Cemetery with memorial services following at 10 AM at Wynne Presbyterian Church.
