Alice Janesta Neill Haynes died at the age of 86, on July 3, 2012, under the care of Patient's Choice Hospice of Forrest City, and of Elder Care of Wynne caregivers Emma Futch, Pat Grisales, and Michelle Neal. Mrs. Haynes was born November 24, 1925, and lived in the Pinetree Community all her life. An employee of Warwick and then Sanyo Industries, she retired to care for husband Jack. Alice was a loving wife, sister, daughter, and aunt; and, she

cared for her mother and husband faithfully during their final illnesses. Alice valued her friends in the community and friends from her work at Warwick and Sanyo. In her later years, she made new friends while working part-time at Wilkins Dress Shop in Colt; and, she loved to purchase new dresses and accessories at the shop.
