Mrs. Barbara Westbrook, age 56, of Wynne died Tuesday, November 2, 2010, at her home. Barbara was an English teacher at Wynne High School for 25 years and a former Wynne High School Cheer Coach for 15 years until she retired in 2010. She was a member of Wynne Presbyterian Church.
