Bobbie Nell Brown (Bobbie) was born on April 1, 1927, in the Mississippi hills. She was the middle child of 3 daughters. Bobbie graduated as Valedictorian of her high school graduating class.

She worked at Cross County Bank in Wynne for many years, earning the title of Vice President.

On December 23, 1948, she married Wylie Brown who was the love of her life. She remained his devoted wife and helpmate for many years until his passing in 2017. Together, they were well known in the community, giving countless gifts large and small to those in need. As members of the Ridgeview Baptist Church, they were active in church leadership, charitable works, and have pews named in their honor.
