Mrs. Bonnye Todd Sisk of Wynne, died peacefully Friday, April 30, 2021, at the Flo and Phil Jones Hospice House in Jonesboro, Arkansas. She was 87.

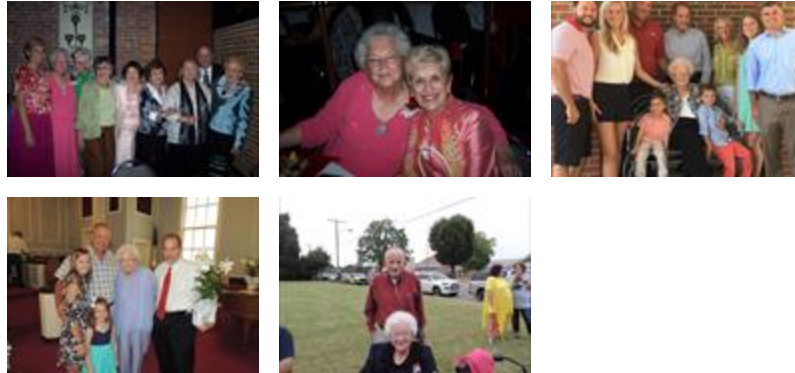
