



## Brooks Maddux Fiscus

June 17, 1929 - January 20, 2022

Brooks Maddux Fiscus, 92, of Wynne, Arkansas, died on Thursday, January 20, 2022, at Unity Health in Searcy, Arkansas. Brooks was born on June 17, 1929, in Crawfordsville, Arkansas, to the late Alfred Maddux and Georgia Alice Sheeks Maddux. She accomplished many things during her 92 years, married Jack Fiscus in 1952, had four wonderful children, taught Home Economics and Family Living for more than 20 combined years at Wynne High School and the Cross County Workshop. Brooks graduated from the University of Arkansas in 1951, was a member of Pi Beta Phi sorority, Guild, Methodist Women, and a member and secretary of Rayda Wallace Circle. She was also a member of the Garden Club, neighborhood coffee group and many other community groups. She was a member of retired teachers, the Go-Getters Sunday School at First United Methodist Church and a 70 plus year member of the First United Methodist Church. She loved playing the Ukulele for Sunday school classes and for her family. Brooks' father was also an educator, serving as school superintendent, so education was very important to her. She was extremely proud that all her children and grandchildren have graduated from college. While her children were growing up, she spent her time being a homemaker. During that time, she helped educate all her children and the neighborhood children. She always had a wonderful smile and a helpful spirit with everyone. Brooks loved her Yellow Jackets and was an avid Arkansas Razorback Fan.

She is survived by her children, Bettye Brooks Fiscus Dickey of Stillwater,

Oklahoma, Jack "Dan" Fiscus and wife Torrie of Longview, Texas, Al Fiscus and wife Danita of Searcy, Arkansas, Martin Fiscus and wife Libby of Bentonville, Arkansas, 11 grandchildren and 7 great grandchildren. She was preceded in death by her parents, Alfred and Georgia Sheeks Maddux, husband, Jack Daniel Fiscus in 1985, brother, Al Maddux, and sisters, Billie Robertson and Alice Wilhoite.
