



## Charles Boeckmann

May 30, 1920 - August 12, 2009

Charles P. Boeckmann, 89, of Wynne passed away Wednesday in Wynne. He was preceded in death by his parents, Henry Sr. and Rose Boeckmann; sister, Elizabeth Frein; and brother, Henry Charles Boeckmann, Jr.

Mr. Boeckmann was a rice farmer, a member of the Knights of Columbus and a member of St. Peter's Catholic Church. His hobbies were hunting, fishing, reading, watching westerns and he was an avid outdoorsman.

Charles attended the Gailey School and helped on the family farm. Charles was inducted into the Army 10 May 1945 at Camp Robinson, Arkansas. His Military Specialty was Stevedore Foreman and he qualified as a Rifle Marksman. He and his unit left for the South Pacific 17 October 1945 and served there until 30 October 1946. He was discharged 14 December 1946 at Fort Sam Houston, Texas having earned the Asiatic-Pacific Theater Campaign Ribbon; the World War II Victory Ribbon; the Army of Occupation Medal (Japan) and one Overseas Service Bar. Charles returned to Cross County and resumed farming.

Survivors are brothers, Otto Boeckmann, Bill Boeckmann, Charles F. (Bud) Boeckmann all of Wynne and sisters, Polly Davis, Joan Hess, Edith Buehnerkemper and Cecilia Diener all of Wynne.

Funeral services will be Friday, 10:00 AM at St. Peter's Catholic Church with burial in Johnson Cemetery in Fair Oaks.

Visitation will be Thursday, 6-8 PM at Kernodle Funeral Home with Rosary beginning at 7 PM.
