



## Charline Rose Hess Jackson

June 22, 1919 - May 13, 2019

Charline Rose Hess Jackson died on Monday, May 13, 2019, in McCrory, Arkansas. She was born in Wynne, AR on June 22, 1919, and was just a few weeks shy of celebrating her 100th birthday. Before her passing, Charline was the oldest living member of the Hess family. Charline was the oldest of 12 children born to Charlie and Mamie Hess. She married Leslie Merel Jackson (deceased) in 1938. They had two children, Jesse Charles Jackson (deceased) and Margaret Ann Catalani.

Charline leaves behind the following family members – her siblings, Dorothy Boeckmann, Richard Hess, Rudy Hess, and Gloria Jean Hess; her daughter, Margaret Ann (Carlo), daughter-in-law Marcella Jackson (Charles), six grandsons – Tommy (Terri), Jon (Leslie), Scott (Mena) and Daniel (Jennifer) Jackson, and Michael (Kristy) and David Catalani. B Charline also has 10 great grandchildren and 4 great-great grandchildren.

Charline's siblings preceding her in death were, Augusta "Gustie", Kathryn, Arthur "Buddy", Martha Ann, Louise, Joe, and John.

Charline and Merel raised their family primarily in Memphis, TN before retiring and moving to Melbourne, AR, more specifically Greasy Bottoms on the White River. After Merel's passing in 1977, she continued to live in the Melbourne area until she moved to the Woodruff County Nursing Home in McCrory, AR in August 2018.
