Dennis Harold Wegert, 80, of Wynne, passed away at 7:00 AM, Saturday, June 24, 2023, at Flo and Phil Hospice House in Jonesboro. He was born on October 29, 1942, in Peru, Indiana to the late Pearl Nemetz Wegert and Henry Wegert. He married Kay Brawner Ransom on June 18, 2012, at First United Methodist Church in Wynne, Arkansas.

Dennis was a 1961 graduate of Peru High School and was a First Classmen graduate of Culver Military Academy Summer School. He graduated from Arkansas State University with his Masters. He taught for one year. He was an Assistant Principal at Douglas MacArthur Junior High School in Jonesboro, Arkansas for 29 years.
