Mrs. Eda Claire Lake Slabaugh of Parkin, Arkansas, died Tuesday, February 7, 2017 at Methodist University Hospital in Memphis, Tennessee.

Eda Claire was born in Wynne, Arkansas on March 9, 1934 to Robert M. and Eda Cunningham Lake. She was the former Mayor of Parkin, taught in the Parkin School District, was a member of the Parkin Garden Club and the City Beautification. She was an avid scrap booker and a big fan of the Arkansas Razorbacks. She was a member of the Parkin United Methodist Church. Eda Claire was devoted to her family and a care giver to many.

She was preceded in death by her husband, Bill Slabaugh in 2000, sister, Jeanette Lake and her parents, Robert and Eda Lake.
