Erma Lee Pribble, 86, a resident of Davenport and former resident of Cross County, Arkansas, died Sunday morning, July 10, 2011, at the Davenport Lutheran Home. God took her to heaven to be with the love of her life, her husband, Elvern, who preceded her in death in 2007.

Erma Lee Jeffers was born May 31, 1925, in Cross County, Arkansas, a daughter of George Fithin and Edna West Jeffers. She was united in marriage to Elvern Glen "Red" Pribble on September 16, 1942.
