Mr. Fred Everett Brenner, Jr., 88, of Parkin, Arkansas passed away Monday, March 19, 2012 at his home in Parkin.

He was preceded in death by his parents, Fred Everett, Sr. and Myrtle Belle Speas Brenner and his wife, Beatrice Louise Phillips Brenner in November 2008.

Mr. Brenner was born in Memphis, Tennessee on April 7, 1923. He was a Graduate of the US Naval Academy, Annapolis, Maryland. Fred served his country during World War II and the Korean Conflict in the US Navy. He retired US Navy and farmer. Fred was a member of the Parkin First United Methodist Church.
