George Elmer Owens, Sr., 85, of Wynne, Arkansas, passed away on March 10, 2025. He was born on January 7, 1940, in DeWitt, Arkansas, to the late Elmer and Syble Shireman Owens. George was a devoted husband, father, grandfather, and great-grandfather. He is preceded in death by his parents and his brother, Jimmy Owens. He is survived by his beloved wife of 63 years, Mary Owens; his brother, Tommy Owens (Jeanne); his son, Joey Owens (Laura); and his daughter, Ginger McFadden (Brett). George was especially proud of his seven grandchildren—Mallory Owens Dollarhite (Kyle), Lathan McFadden (Kelsey), Landon McFadden (Hannah), Sydney Owens Harrod (Alex), Luke McFadden (Sydney), Jake Owens (Hayley), and Ley McFadden—as well as his three great-grandchildren and many nieces and nephews. George was a member of Cross Community Church of Wynne. He farmed in the Jolly Ellis community, where he raised his family. He was dedicated to his work and his community, serving in numerous leadership roles, including 25 years on the Wynne School Board, where he served as president for many years and was a former president of the Arkansas School Board Association. He was also the former president of the Cross County Farmers Association, served on the MFA Oil Board, and was a past president of the Wynne Fumble Club. Additionally, George contributed his time to the Cross County Hospital Board and the St. Bernards Advisory Board. Beyond his professional and civic endeavors, George proudly served in the National Guard. He was a former member of the Wynne Rotary Club and was formerly a Mason and a Shriner.

He had a passion for tennis and was a fierce competitor on and off the court. More than anything, George cherished time spent with his family and friends. George's life was a testament to hard work, service, and love for those around him. His impact on the Wynne community and beyond will be deeply missed, but his legacy will continue through his family and the many lives he touched.
