If she were not with them physically, she was present mentally and emotionally requesting stories of their many activities and accomplishments. She and Greg shared their excitement for high fashion and style while Jay shared his sports enthusiasm and Mollie shared her love of Razorback football.

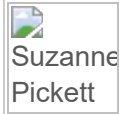
