Guy E. Fisher, Jr., 87, of Colt, Arkansas, died on Friday, January 13, 2023, at home.

Mr. Fisher was born in Pine Tree, Arkansas, on December 26, 1935, to the late Guy E. Fisher, Sr. and Mae Devasier Fisher. He married Nina Marie Walter in 1953 and they had three children, Tim, Debbie, and Dewayne. He owned three grocery stores in Arkansas and one in Missouri with one being Fishers IGA in Wynne. In 2000, Mr. Fisher retired from the grocery business and closed his Wynne store. He served on the Cross County Bank Board of Directors for many years.

He is survived by son, Tim Fisher and wife Becky of Wynne, daughter, Debbie Meadows and husband Ray of Wynne, brother, Alvin Fisher and wife Sherry of Forrest City, seven grandchildren, and several great grandchildren.

He was preceded in death by his parents, Guy E. Fisher, Sr. and Mae Devasier Fisher, wife, Nina Marie Fisher in 2022, and son, Dewayne Fisher.
