Lawrence Edward Taylor Jr., 89, entered heaven on Sunday, November 5, 2023, at his residence in Mont Belvieu, Texas surrounded by his loving family. He was born on September 21, 1934, in Magnolia, Arkansas, to Lawrence Edward Taylor Sr. and Eva Mae Henderson Taylor.

Lawrence graduated from Bradley High School in Arkansas. He received a Bachelor of Arts degree in Education from Ouachita Baptist College in Arkadelphia, Arkansas and earned a Masters of Science degree in Education at Arkansas State University. He taught in several school districts in Arkansas and later became a principal at Wynne Jr. High School. In 1973 he began a career in the insurance industry working at Farm Bureau Insurance Agency. After several years, he became an independent agent for various companies and served as President of the Eastern Underwriters Association. Lawrence also served as an elected City Council Member of Wynne, Arkansas.

He was known for his love of dancing as he taught at the Arthur Murray Dance Studio in Dallas, Texas. He also enjoyed playing dominoes, Bridge, and other card games. He was an active member of his church and readily shared the gospel of Jesus Christ.

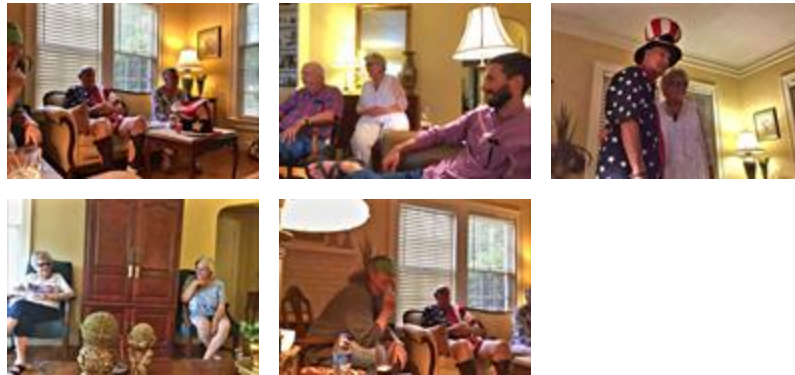
