Mrs. Lillian "Lill" Ann Wisemore Wilson of Wynne age 80, passed away Sunday, June 6, 2010 at her home church, Central United Methodist in Wynne.

She was preceded in death by her parents, George O. Wisemore and Louise Stewart Wisemore and her husband, Arthur N. Wilson.

Mrs. Wilson was born in Wynne on May 19, 1930, she spent her childhood years in Wynne. She was a 1947 graduate of Wynne High School and graduated in 1950 from the Methodist Hospital Nursing School. When she married the late Arthur Wilson, she moved to the Memphis community and worked as a surgical nurse for the Methodist Healthcare System until retiring in 1990 from Methodist South Hospital. She returned to the Wynne community in 1991. Lill was extremely active in her community. She loved caring for family, friends, and animals in the community. Lill served as a volunteer with the CrossRidge Community Hospital Auxiliary. She was a member of the Cross County Extension Club and the Wynne Friends of Animals.

She is survived by her sons, George A. Wilson and wife Robin of Memphis, Tennessee and Mark Wilson and wife Misty of Olive Branch, Mississippi; and grandchildren, Amy Louise Wilson, Tyler Stewart Wilson and Samuel Garrett Wilson.
