



## Lucile Kernodle McGuire

June 16, 1913 - August 1, 2014

Erma Lucile Kernodle McGuire, age 101, of Wynne, Arkansas, passed away Friday, August 1, 2014, at RiverRidge Nursing Home.

Lucile was born June 16, 1913 in Birdeye, Arkansas, to William Claude and Mickie Jones Kernodle. She moved from Parkin to Wynne in 1927 and graduated from Wynne High School in 1931 and Arkansas College in 1935. She taught the first four grades at Central Community and grade school at Wynne Elementary School. In 1938, Lucile married Sam A. McGuire, Jr. They owned and operated McGuire's Drug Store until Sam passed away in 1992. She was a life-long member of Wynne First United Methodist Church.
