Mrs. Murray Ann Engelhart, of Wynne passed away Wednesday in Memphis, Tennessee.

She was preceded in death by her parents, Bruce Fisher and Grace Sheridan Fisher.

Murray Ann was a graduate of Wynne High School and of Pacific Western university in California. Murray Ann performed with the Houston Symphony Orchestra, Houston Grand Opera Association, Houston Gilbert and Sullivan Society, Junior League of Houston, University of Iowa Symphony and the Windsor Light Opera Company. She returned to Arkansas where she taught voice and piano at the High School and College levels. She returned to Cross County in 1970 where she taught private piano and voice lessons. She was currently teaching at West Memphis Christian Academy. Mrs. Engelhart was a member of the First United Methodist Church of Wynne.
