Myrtle Standridge Bradshaw, a longtime resident of Wynne, passed away peacefully at her home on January 24, 2018. She was born September 15, 1922 to Lester and Elvia Standridge in Mt. Ida, Arkansas. She was preceded in death by her parents, her husband Afton Bradshaw, two sisters, Norma Standridge and Maurita Stroope, and one brother, Fred Standridge, one sister-in-law, Lestal Standridge.
