Ola Mae McCammon, 66, of Wynne, Arkansas passed away Friday, June 18 in her home surrounded by family and friends. Her passing followed a courageous and dignified battle with Progressive Supra Nuclear Palsy. She was a loving mother, grandmother, and sister who will be missed tremendously.

Ola Mae was born December, 23, 1943 in Alpin, Arkansas to Dot and Rebel Dolye. She grew up in Cherry Valley, Arkansas, the youngest of 7 children. She was a 1961 graduate of Cherry Valley High School.

progressed.
