Mr. Paul Hogan, age 83, of Wynne, passed away Tuesday, November 10, 2009 at CrossRidge Community Hospital.

Mr. Hogan was preceded in death by his parents, Irvin Hogan and Ester Anderson Hogan; brothers, A. W. Hogan and Ray Hogan; and sister, Kathleen Hogan Jordan.

Mr. Hogan was born in Cherry Valley, Arkansas on February 28, 1926. He was retired from farming and Halstead, having also worked at IGA and Wal-Mart.
