



## Timothy Allen Loyd

March 16, 1983 - October 3, 2020

Technical Sergeant Timothy Allen Loyd, age 37, of Goldsboro, North Carolina, Seymour Johnson Air Force Base, died on October 3, 2020.

Tim was born on March 16, 1983, to Ricky Loyd and Kathie Carraway. Tim joined the United States Air Force when he was 19 years old in 2002, and served our country over 18 years, his whole adult life. He served many deployments overseas and was proud to be considered one of the “dirt boyz” for the Air Force. 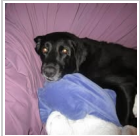

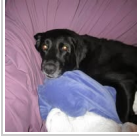
