Todd Douglas Brewington was born on October 20, 1962, to Harold and Ruth (Spears) Brewington, in Flint, Michigan. He spent most of his childhood in Forrest City, Arkansas, with his parents and his two older brothers, Joey and Scott.

If you could ask him what he was most proud of, his answers would be his military service, his kids, and his cooking. He was a United States Marine Corporal, anti-terrorism instructor, and spent several deployments overseas in parts of Africa, including Somalia during America's Operation Restore Hope, to aid in famine relief during the Somali civil war. He won many medals of honor. He loved telling stories about his life as a marine, often reminiscing on parachuting jumps and his years as a gun instructor. He was honorably discharged in April of 1993.

He was a phenomenal cook, very well-read, and enjoyed target practice. He had a great sense of humor, loved animals, and was a hard worker. His Marine years made him tough and in his own words, reminded him to "never give up."

He is survived by his daughter, Camille Brewington-Bonds and husband Joey, lifetime companion and friend, Jerre Trimue Douglas, 10 grandchildren, his brother, Scott Brewington, and many nieces and nephews. He is preceded in

death by both of his parents, Harold and Ruth Brewington, his brother Joey Brewington, and his beloved son, Caleb Brewington.

Todd passed away on December 1, 2023, after a difficult battle with cancer. As a true Marine, he fought like hell to the very end. He will be truly missed and always remembered by those who loved him.

A service celebrating the life of Mr. Brewington will be held on Friday, December 8, 2023. at 130 PM at the Arkansas State Veteran's Cemetery at Birdeye with military honors. Kernodle Funeral Home is in charge of arrangements.
