Tracey Glen Foster, age 66, of Wynne, Arkansas, was born July 27, 1959, and died on July 30, 2025. Known by many as “Crazy Man,” Tracey was a one-of-a-kind personality—quick with a laugh, generous with his stories, and unforgettable to anyone who met him.

Growing up in Crawfordsville, Tracey was surrounded by a large family, including 7 siblings. He spent much of his working life at Southeastern Freight, where he was respected for his strong memorable personality. He later retired from the Arkansas State Highway Department, where he made many lasting friendships and left a lasting impression on colleagues and community alike. In retirement, Tracey held court on his front porch, his favorite spot in the world. He could be found visiting with neighbors, out sharing breakfast and coffee with friends, running errands or lending a helping hand for friends and family, or enjoying his ‘retirement naps’.

He enjoyed dirt track racing, and he never missed a chance to try his hand at video poker, always with a grin and a quip ready. He spent many summers at the baseball fields as an umpire. These hobbies reflected the spontaneous, fun-loving side of Tracey that everyone remembered.

Tracey was preceded in death by his parents, Parnell and Christine Foster, and four siblings: Peggy Stricklen, Leroy, Kenneth, and Ronnie Foster. He is survived by his wife, Laura Boeckmann Foster, of the home; siblings Danny Foster and wife Dorothy, sister Mary Ellis and husband Ron, Terry Foster and wife Trish; two sons, Tony Foster of Marion and David Foster of Las Vegas,

NV; one daughter, Ravan White of Billings, Montana; Five grandchildren, and several nieces and nephews who adored their “Crazy Man” uncle and the light he brought to every family gathering.
