Veda Sue Fannin, age 78, of McCrory and formerly Hawk Cove, TX, passed away peacefully Tuesday morning, April 7, 2026, at the Unity Health Center in Searcy. She had been in the hospital for the past two weeks.

Mrs. Fannin was born June 30, 1947, in Wynne, and was the daughter of William Murray Crippen and Alma LaDell Morris Crippen. She was a retired secretary for the city of Hawk Cove, Texas, and was a Baptist.
