



Vonnie Fowler Lawson

March 24, 1936 - February 6, 2026

Vonnie Beth Fowler Lawson, 89, passed from this life to her eternal home on Friday, February 6, 2026, after a short illness. She was born as the third of four children on March 24, 1936, to W. O. and Doris Bostick Fowler. She was raised as part of a farming family in the years of the Great Depression where she learned about hard work and thriftiness that were necessary for survival, characteristics never forgotten. She often recalled her father buying a tract of land, and they all worked digging stumps to clear it for crop production.

She attended Wynne High School, where she met R. L. Lawson. Their marriage was blessed with two sons, Vance and Scott. As in most families of the 50s, her life was centered around her family and home, but Vonnie also worked alongside R. L. They initially operated a service station on Front Street, but in 1967, R. L. started Lawson Insurance. Vonnie worked in the office as an integral part of the success of that agency, which continues with their son.

Their life outside of work and family was devoted to worship and activities at Union Avenue Baptist Church. In the early days of Union Avenue Baptist, Vonnie and R. L. responded to an invitation to attend a church service that led to their acceptance of Christ. They followed Him faithfully with that congregation for the rest of their years.

Vonnie was devoted to her parents, husband, and sister, Willene Hampton, who preceded her in death. She is survived by her beloved sons, Vance Lawson and wife Sharon, and Scott Lawson all of Wynne; her two grandchildren, Robert Lawson and Sarah Lawson Barber (John), who gave her such joy in her later years; and two great-granddaughters, Chloe and Iris Barber. She is also survived by her sister Kathryn Milton, brother David "Buddy" Fowler (Dana), nieces, and nephews.

Visitation will be held on Tuesday, February 10, 2026, from 1 to 2:30 at Kernodle Funeral Home. Funeral services will follow at 2:30 with burial in Harris Chapel Cemetery.
