Mr. William "Billy" Sidney Bledsoe, 98, of Wynne, Arkansas, died at home on Friday, November 22, 2024.

Billy was born in Vanndale, Cross County, Arkansas, to Neal and Effie Crawford Bledsoe, on December 22, 1925. He farmed B and B Bledsoe Brothers Farms. The brothers were quite famous for their farm raised catfish. Billy proudly served his country in the United States Army during World War II, Company A 240th Engineer Construction Battalion. He enjoyed working crossword puzzles, watching westerns, going for drives, hunting and fishing.
